Oversight

The Authority is mandated by the Government of Quebec to oversee Quebec's financial markets. It ensures the protection of the public by enforcing the legislation and regulations governing the financial sector. The ChAD ensures the protection of the public by maintaining discipline and overseeing the training and ethical behaviour of damage insurance agents and brokers, as well as claims adjusters.

Organizations, groups, and associations

Tools, promotion of the profession, relevant documents, networking, professional development: information on industry organizations, groups and associations that offer a variety of useful resources.

Other resources

These are organizations that insureds can turn to for information and to understand their rights as consumers of damage insurance products. Insureds can also contact the Authority and the ChAD for consumer information.
